Woodpecker is able to peck 20 times per second. It produces between 10,000 and 12,000 pecks per day.







Most of us know that woodpeckers have very long tongue so that they can catch the prey from the depth of the holes of the trees but do you know that many woodpeckers have barbed tongues that help them extract bugs from trees and holes!



Woodpeckers have very long tongue which is designed for capturing of prey that is hidden inside the trees.



Woodpeckers don't have any vocal cords that means they can't make a sound.

Drumming trees with their beaks play an important part of their communication with each other!





Although pecking of the trees looks like activity that may hurt woodpecker, bird does not feel the pain at all. Brain is prevented from trauma thanks to special air pockets in the scull.
